ABOUT THE ABMDR

Hundreds of ethnic Armenians throughout the world suffer from life-threatening blood diseases and need a bone marrow transplant to save their lives. Every day patients and families race against time to find a match and save their loved one before time runs out.

The Armenian Bone Marrow Donor Registry (ABMDR) responds to these families in crisis. It helps find the one person, anywhere in the world, who could serve as that perfect match for that patient, and save his/her life. This savior could be YOU, or your best friend, or your neighbor.

Because of the unique genetic makeup of Armenians, it is nearly impossible to find suitable matches for Armenian patients amongst the existing international registries. Therefore, a great number of Armenian children and adults lose their lives due to the lack of compatible donors. ABMDR was established to address this imbalance and build a unique donor base large enough to find a compatible donor for every Armenian who suffers from Leukemia and needs a bone marrow transplant. ABMDR recruits donors in Armenia and the Diaspora, collects a simple cheek swab, analyzes these tissue samples using state-of-the-art DNA technology, and quickly cross-references this information in a confidential database. Advances in technology make transplantation as simple as a blood transfusion. ABMDR's Los Angeles representatives work as volunteers and will be glad to address all your questions and concerns about the process.
